INVITATION TO APPLY FOR ELIGIBILITY AND TO BID
BAC-IAEB NO. 2008-06

The Research Institute for Tropical Medicine (RITM) through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invites suppliers/manufacturers/distributors to apply for eligibility and to bid for the hereunder project:

Name of Project : Supply and delivery of Chick Embryo Cell Inj. Vaccine, Drugs & Medicines and Medical Supplies

Location: RITM, Filinvest Corporate City, Alabang, Muntinlupa City

ABC: P4,796,650.00

Documents required to be submitted for "Me Too Drugs".

1. CPR (Cert. of Product Registration)
2. Current Batch Certificate for antimicrobials
3. Certificate of Current Good Manufacturing Practice (cGMP) of the production plant/facility where the product was manufactured
4. Bioavailability/Bioequivalence Study of List B Drugs
5. Drug assay or dissolution procedure result done at PGH,UST and Adamson
6. Clinical trials conducted locally (for rabies vaccine, ERIG)
7. Clinical trials conducted locally or in other countries (for HRIG vaccine)
8. Developmental trials for specific brand or expert review (for other vaccines)
9. Lot release certificate

Documents required for Medical Supplies:

1. CPR
2. ISO

Interested bidders are required to adhere to the following procedures during and after the bidding:

For Vaccines:

1. That during the Post Evaluation, the lowest calculated bid shall be subjected to:
 - a. Inspection of the Cold Chain Facility (for all vaccines/immunoglobulin)
 - b. The product shall be tested by RITM for anti-body titer using RFFIT and purity using Sodium Dodecyl Sulfate-Polyacrylamide Electrophoresis (SDS-PAGE) (for ERIG Only)
2. That after the product has been procured by RITM from the winning supplier and was found after use to be associated with development of minor adverse reactions of > 10% or major adverse reaction (such as anaphylaxis or serum sickness) of more than 2%, the winning Bidder/Supplier shall voluntary withdraw their product and refund the payment made by RITM corresponding to the withdrawn product.

For Drugs and Medicines:

After the product has been procured by RITM from the winning supplier, if clinical experience is not favorable and/or the physical appearance differ from the actual appearance stated in the product monograph or product insert, the drug shall be subjected to assay and dissolution procedure and the company shall be required the following:

1. Pay RITM the amount equivalent to the cost of the test. Such amount shall be set by RITM.
2. Provide the reference standard.
3. Replace or pay the equivalent number of tablets/capsules/vials/ampoules used.

If the results show that the drug is substandard, the company shall be subsequently blacklisted. Furthermore, the supplier shall voluntarily withdraw the drug and refund RITM the equivalent amount.

All particulars relative to Eligibility Statement and Screening, Bid Security, Performance Security, Pre-bidding Conference(s), Evaluation of Bids, Post-Qualification and Award of Contract shall be governed by the pertinent provisions of R.A. 9184 and its Implementing Rules and Regulation (IRR).

Bid documents will be available only to prospective bidders upon payment of a non-refundable amount of Five Hundred Pesos (P500.00) to the RITM Cashier.

RITM reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to annul the bidding process anytime prior to the award of contract, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders or any obligation to inform the affected bidder or bidders of the grounds for the RITM's action.
